



Dear Saarloos admirers,

As you may know by now, after almost 30 years of research, the hereditary disease PCYT2 Deficiency (PCYT2-D or PD) has been discovered by the University of Bern in Switzerland. In early October, owners who donated blood from their Saarlooswolfdog received an e-mail with the test results of their Saarlooswolfdog and some 630 results were sent out.

However, there are still 157 results from already deceased dogs whose owner or e-mail address could not be found.

Through the organisation Saarlooswolfdog International, the European breed clubs have received a list with the names of these dogs and their test results.

Do you have a deceased Saarloos wolfhound whose blood was sent in the past and would like to know the result?
